SCS TO PROVIDE DESIGN/BUILD AND MANAGEMENT SUPPORT ON THE \$565 MILLION HAYNES GENERATING STATION UNITS REPOWERING PROJECT FOR LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND POWER

LOS ANGELES, CA (October 10, 2011) -- Seville Construction Services, Inc. (SCS) announced today that they are a part of a team that was selected to provide Engineering, Procurement, and Construction (EPC) services for the \$565 million Haynes Generating Station Units Repowering Project.

The project proposes to construct a combined-cycle electrical generating system, take the existing Units 5 and 6 steam boilers out of service, and make necessary changes to the facility to accommodate the new system.

The goal of the project is to provide reliable and efficient energy demands of the City of Los Angeles, while reducing air pollutant emissions, thus improving air quality in the South Coast Air Basin.

The Los Angeles Department of Water & Power (LADWP) implemented a plan to concentrate its efforts on four projects for re-powering 10 of its 18 Los Angeles Basin generating units over a ten year period, with Units 5 and 6 being part of the plan. Re-powering and modernization of existing plants is an economic and environmentally sound alternative to new plant construction. LADWP is the nation's largest municipal utilities department in Los Angeles and serves more than four million residents and businesses.

"We are thrilled to be a part of the Kiewit Power team again," said Jeff Flores, President/CEO of SCS. "We have been involved with multiple power projects for the LADWP as part of their \$1.7 billion Integrated Resource Program (IRP) over the past 10 years, as well the Haynes Generating Station Units 3 and 4 Repowering, and the Sun Valley Repowering Project, which received a 'Project Achievement Award' from the *Los Angeles Council of Engineers and Scientists*," he added. "So we are well familiar with the requirements of the project, and are ready to hit the ground running to deliver yet another successful project to LADWP."
