SCS IS PART OF A TEAM THAT WINS \$600.4 MILLION CONTRACT TO DESIGN AND BUILD SIX-MILE-LONG EASTSIDE LIGHT RAIL EXTENSION IN LOS ANGELES

LOS ANGELES, California, Jun 21, 2004 – Seville Construction Services, Inc. (SCS) announced today that is part of a joint venture team led by Washington Group that was awarded a \$600.4 million contract to design and build a six-mile-long extension to the Metro Gold Line light rail system in Los Angeles.

The contract was awarded by the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) to Eastside LRT Constructors, a joint venture of Washington Group (sponsor and 50 percent participant), Obayashi Inc. (35 percent), and Shimmick Construction Co. (15 percent). Construction will begin in early August and the project is scheduled for completion in 2009.

The new line named the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension will run from Union Station in downtown Los Angeles to Pomona Boulevard.

"We are honored to be playing another important role in bringing the advantages of light rail transit to Southern California commuters," said Jeff Flores, President and CEO of SCS. Flores said SCS was also part of a joint-venture team that recently completed a \$300 million design-build contract for a 13.7-mile-long segment of the Gold Line that runs from Union Station to Pasadena.

Some four miles of the dual-line Eastside Extension will be constructed at ground level or on bridges or other structures and almost two miles in 21-foot-diameter twin tunnels. The project also includes two underground stations, six aboveground stations, and installation of the overhead catenary system, along with considerable excavation, and signaling and communications systems.

SCS has a long history of involvement in Los Angeles area major transportation projects including the \$300 million LA to Pasadena Metro Gold Line, and the firms current involvement in building the \$880 million East LA Rail Extension for the LA County MTA.
